We want our class to be a fair and happy place.

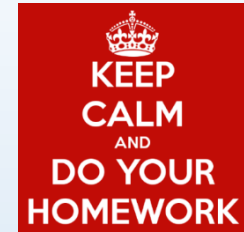

Home Learning



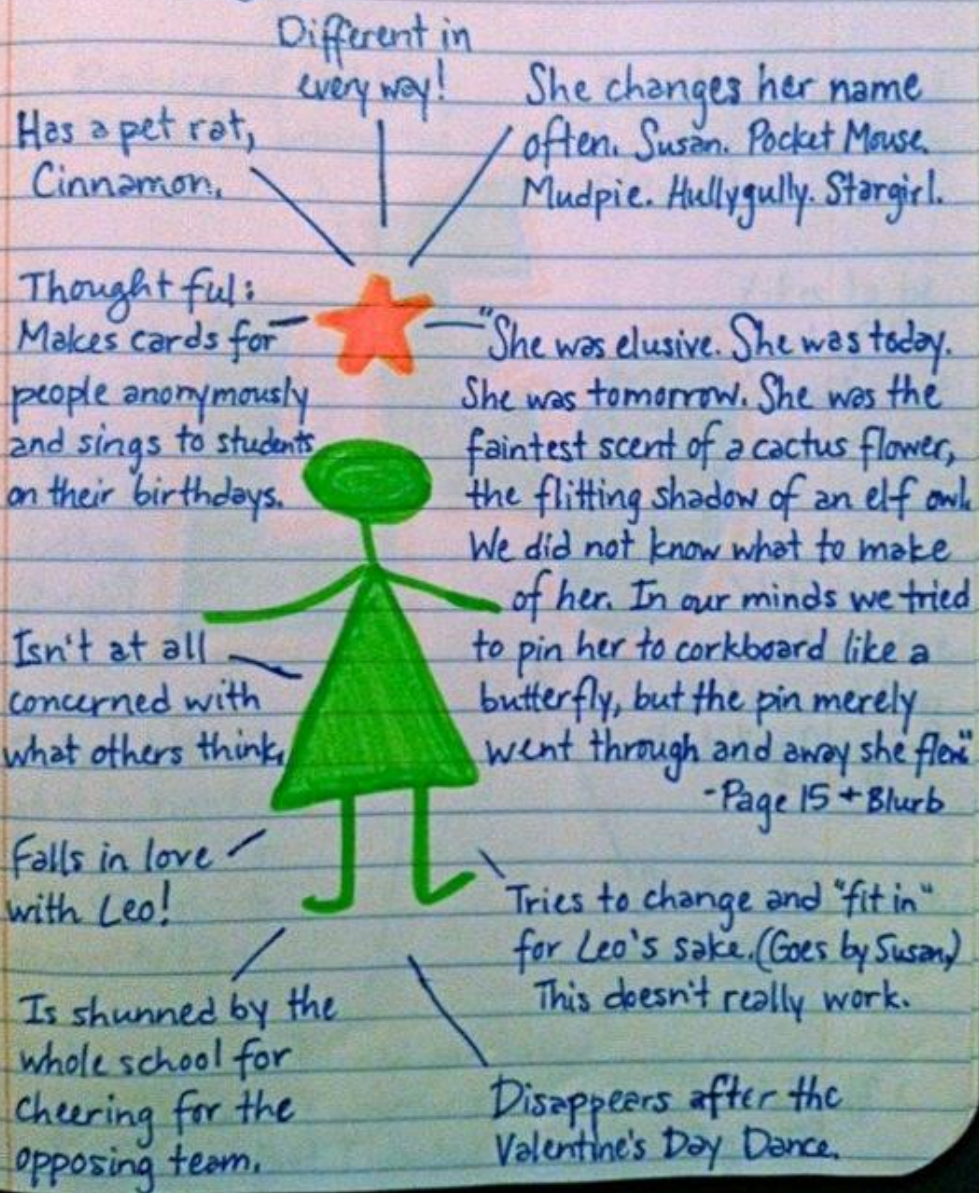
- Home Learning will be monitored on a weekly basis
- Year 6 have access to Maths Whizz 1:1 tutoring - 20/25 mins in school every Friday. Expectation is that they will complete at least 60 mins a week including the time on Fridays. Usage will be checked on the following Thursday. Encouraged to come to Home learning Club on Thursday. If not completed they will need to stay in on Friday lunchtime to complete.
- Reading Journals - checked weekly. Should be in school everyday.
- Creative projects - Topic linked projects which will be completed over a longer period of time.
- Encourage use of Times Table Rock Stars

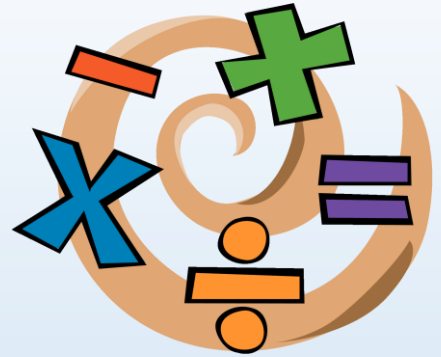

How to help your child at home

- Practise times tables - NC expectation that they should know their times tables by end of Year 4
- Maths in real life contexts - money, time, measuring
